Publication of Prospectus in relation to the Admission of 198,089,847 New Ordinary Shares issued to the National Pensions Reserve Fund Commission on 13 May 2010

("AIB") [NYSE: AIB] (the "Company") announces that a prospectus relating to the admission of 198,089,847 new ordinary shares of the Company, issued by way of bonus issue on 13 May 2010 to the National Pensions Reserve Fund Commission, to the Official Lists of the Irish Stock Exchange and the UK Listing Authority and to trading on the respective regulated markets for listed securities of the Irish Stock Exchange and the London Stock Exchange (the "Prospectus") was today approved by the Irish Financial Regulator, as competent authority under the Prospectus Directive.
